Small and quiet, the Nasal-Aire II Petite nasal cannula mask was designed for patients over seven years of age who require positive airway pressure therapy for Sleep Disordered Breathing.

Sharing the same comfort and compliance benefits of the Nasal-Aire technology, its simplistic, easy-to-use design makes it **ideal for younger patients**.

- Virtually leak-free and ergonomically **designed to fit the smallest of faces**
- Minimalistic design **virtually eliminates pressure points** on the face allowing the interface to be worn for extended periods of time without discomfort
- Nasal cannula design optimizes seal within the nose, **offers an unobstructed line of sight** and helps to reduce feelings of claustrophobia
- **Headgear with secure fit design** allows the user to sleep in most any position comfortably
- **Built-in swivel** prevents tubing from pulling and kinking, allowing a more comfortable, uninterrupted night's sleep

- Designed for patients over 7 years of age or weighing more than 40 lbs.
- Hanging tubing reduces moisture build-up underneath the nose
- Lack of nasal bridge and forehead contact **virtually eliminates sores and air leaks near eyes**
- **Easy to fit**, ergonomically designed Micro headgear with patented elbow feature reduces facial pressure points for added comfort
- Patients can rest comfortably in various positions without the constraint of traditional nasal masks and bulky headgear
- Simplistic design **requires less parts than traditional nasal mask systems** and makes interface easy for pediatric patients to assemble and clean
- Available in five sizes smaller than the Nasal-Aire II extra small
