

## PAD A CHEEK®

## Mask Liner FFB

## Quattro FX

## Extra Padding Included, tuck into the pocket if needed

- Remove the headgear from the mask, and lay the Mask Liner flat (photo #1).
- Squeeze the side pieces together and slide under the sewn strap (photo #2). This feels awkward.
- Then pull the sewn strap with the Velcro down onto the body of the mask (photo #3) This is a tight fit.
- Pull the top of the mask liner over the top of the mask line (photo #4).
- Put the elbow of the mask thru the round hole in the bottom of the liner.
- Attach the Velcro. If the mask liner needs to be smaller, roll the bottom Velcro over before attaching it (Photo #5). Make certain no exhalation vents are covered with the Mask Liner.
- Smooth the Mask Liner over the cushion and under the "arms" of the mask. (photo #6)
- Attach the straps to your mask.

Note: You may need to cut the hole larger to accommodate your nose or mouth, do this with sharp scissors a little bit at a time. It is very easy to get the hole too large.
