



Mask Liner **Wisp**




- Remove the seal from the mask
- Place the seal into the mask liner (Photo #2 & #3). The wide part of the mask cushion should be against the label.
- Pull the flap over the hole of the seal, pulling it over the edge of the flange. It will stretch.
- Repeat this for the other flap (Photo #5).
- Snap the headgear over the hole and the flaps of the mask liner (Photo #6).

Make certain no exhalation vents are covered with the PAD A CHEEK- Wisp Mask Liner. Note: You may need to cut the hole larger to accommodate your nose, do this with

sharp scissors <u>a little bit at a time</u>. It is very easy to get the hole too large.













The PAD A CHEEK Wisp Mask Liner is made from 100% polyester microfiber, and can be machine or hand washed with warm water. If you have any questions, please contact me.
